Dr. Ernie Bodai, CEO of CureBreastCancer, Inc, and a Kaiser Permanente Surgeon, in a continuing effort to support research, led the all-volunteer, grassroots lobbying effort to create the Breast Cancer Research Postal Stamp. The money raised from the sale of the stamp is divided between the National Institutes of Health and the Defense Department's Health Research Division, as called for by Congress. We have the 2007 GAO report on the latest fund raising results of the stamp that was presented to Congress.
